



The Premier League Basketball **RULES SUMMARY**

Welcome to the Athens Premier League! For all coaches, assistants, parents & players, I would like to outline how the Athens Premier League will operate during the season. Here are the guidelines:

Rules:

We will play by GHSA rules with 2 exceptions:

- 15 pt. Lead - No full court press for team in the lead (1/2 court only). Press can be reinstated at 10 point lead.
- 20 pt. Lead – (2nd half-only) Running clock unless opposing team can reduce lead to 12 pts. or less

Ball Size:

28.5 3rd – 6th, 29.5 for 7th grade. **Coaches are responsible for bringing warm-up ball for their team.**

Goal Height: 10 ft-regulation

Time:

- 7th /6th/5th Grade - 4 Quarters of 6 minutes with 3 minutes for Halftime and Overtime (if necessary).
- 3/4th Grade - 4 Quarters of 5 minutes with 3 minutes for
- Halftime and Overtime (if necessary).

Time Outs: 3 full (1 minute) and 2 (30 second) time outs per game.

Playing Time: The Athens Premier League does not require or mandate playing time.

Coaches:

- 1 Head Coach and 1 Assistant Coach-No exceptions
- a) No additional coaches/parents behind, beside or on the bench
- b) More than 2 Coaches on the bench will result in:
 - 1st offense = Warning
 - 2nd or more offenses = Technical foul

Clock Operator or Bookkeeper- The Premier League provides a clock operator and each team shall provide bookkeeper for each game. We ask that coaches identify the individual prior to game time.

Admission: \$3.00 per Adult and Children Free for regular season games but subject to \$2.00 per Child between 2 and 18 years of age. Tournament and All-stars will have a gate charge of \$5.00 per Adult and \$2.00 per Child.

- a) Coaches – 1 Head Coach and 1 Assistant per team will be admitted for free but must sign in at the admission table.
- b) Clock Operator or Bookkeeper (1 per team) will be admitted for free but must sign in at the admission table.

Concessions: Candy, snacks and drinks may be available at the concessions stand in the entrance lobbies of facilities when possible.

All-Star Game:

In the Premier League, each age group is divided into divisions. Each division will have an All-Star team to play against each other. There will be a coaches meeting during the second half of the season to select the All-Stars. The games will be played on during the end of season tournament week.

Championship Playoffs:

The Championship Playoffs will be played the week of the All-Star game and will culminate with the Championship Game for each age group.

The guidelines stated above are intended to help all of us in our effort to make this another successful season in the Premier League.
